Protocol Review



- Reviewers cannot make any assumptions
- It should be clear how the project will go from A to B, B to C,...
- Clear justification for the need to do the project
- Complete packet:
 - Application, protocol, consent forms, assent forms, questionnaires, scripts, letters of support, letters of approval, tribal resolutions, other IRB approvals, budget, timeline, NIH grant application, resumes, brochures, fliers

What is a Protocol?

- The plan or blueprint for your research study
- Should include:
 - Purpose, rationale, and significance of the research
 - Methods and procedures
 - Recruitment and informed consent process
 - Risks and benefits
 - Costs and compensation
 - Privacy and confidentiality
- The protocol may be modified over time, where as the application is specific to the initial review, an amendment, a continuing review, etc.

Protocol Review

- Methods survey, focus group, interviews, medical chart reviews, secondary data analyses, clinical trial
- Recruitment number, sex, age, means, inclusion/exclusion criteria

- **Privacy and confidentiality** protected health information, security, access
- Risk and benefits individual, family and community levels

- Analyses types of tests, interpretation of the findings, ability to assess what
 is proposed
- Reporting, dissemination plan ongoing regular updates, participant reports, tribal review prior to release or publication

Particular attention to studies involving:

- * Minors
- * Prisoners
- * Pregnant women and fetuses
- * Students
- * Cognitively Impaired


Required Elements of Consent

- Purpose, Duration of Participation, and Procedures (inclusion criteria, audio/video recording, etc.)
- 2. Risks (side effects, discomforts, etc.)
- 3. Benefits (to the participant, to society, etc.)
- 4. Alternatives to Participation
- 5. Confidentiality
- Emergency Treatment & Compensation for Injury (if more than minimal risk)
- 7. Questions
- 8. Withdrawal



Additional Elements of Consent


- 1. Pregnancy (risk to subject, embryo, or fetus is subject may become pregnant)
- 2. Termination by Investigator
- 3. Additional Cost to Subject
- 4. Consequences of Withdrawal
- 5. New Findings
- 6. Number of Subjects Involved





§46.116 - Informed Consent Checklist - Basic and Additional Elements



A statement that the study involves research

An explanation of the purposes of the research

The expected duration of the subject's participation

A description of the procedures to be followed

Identification of any procedures which are experimental

A description of any reasonably foreseeable risks or discomforts to the subject

A description of any benefits to the subject or to others which may reasonably be expected from the research

A disclosure of appropriate alternative procedures or courses of treatment, if any, that might be advantageous to the subject

A statement describing the extent, if any, to which confidentiality of records identifying the subject will be maintained

For research involving more than minimal risk, an explanation as to whether any compensation, and an explanation as to whether any medical treatments are available, if injury occurs and, if so, what they consist of, or where further information may be obtained

- () Research Qs
- () Rights Qs
- () Injury Qs

An explanation of whom to contact for answers to pertinent questions about the research and research subjects' rights, and whom to contact in the event of a research-related injury to the subject

A statement that participation is voluntary, refusal to participate will involve no penalty or loss of benefits to which the subject is otherwise entitled, and the subject may discontinue participation at any time without penalty or loss of benefits, to which the subject is otherwise entitled

Additional elements, as appropriate



A statement that the particular treatment or procedure may involve risks to the subject (or to the embryo or fetus, if the subject is or may become pregnant), which are currently unforeseeable

Anticipated circumstances under which the subject's participation may be terminated by the investigator without regard to the subject's consent

Any additional costs to the subject that may result from participation in the research

The consequences of a subject's decision to withdraw from the research and procedures for orderly termination of participation by the subject

A statement that significant new findings developed during the course of the research, which may relate to the subject's willingness to continue participation, will be provided to the subject
