The TAC, first established in 2005, serves an important advisory role for CDC and ATSDR, providing input and guidance about policies, guidelines, and programmatic issues affecting the health of Indian tribes and American Indian/Alaska Native people.

Please share the vacancy announcement with your tribal leader partners located in the Billings area to encourage them to nominate elected tribal officials to represent their area on the TAC. Nominated area delegates must be qualified to represent the views of tribes within the area, from an area perspective. CDC/ATSDR is recruiting for these vacancies through February 18, 2022.
